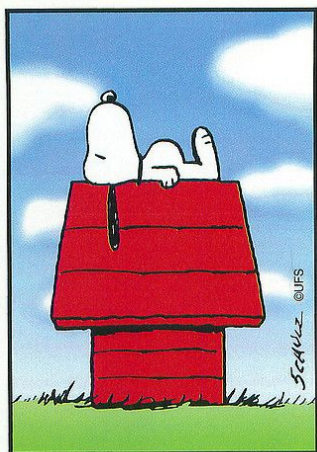


A **preposition** is a word that connects a noun or pronoun to other words to show the relationship between them. A *prepositional phrase* includes the preposition, noun, or pronoun (the object of the preposition). Most prepositional phrases include a modifier, but some do not.
