The Challenge

Mercy Health provides a wide range of healthcare for Western Michigan, including lab and pharmaceutical services. This requires tight controls around maintaining temperature to ensure efficacy of vaccines and medication stored in their fridges and freezers. Temperature control is necessary for compliance, but more importantly, for the safety of Mercy Health's patients. Before SmartSense, Mercy Health was spending valuable time maintaining paper logs, which led to loss product as a result of these manual processes.

Mercy Health collaborated with SmartSense, a leading IoT company, to implement two key capabilities:

- Continuous temperature monitoring to improve patient safety and reduce medication loss
- Automated compliance logging that redirects valuable time to interacting directly with patients

The Solution

Continuous Temperature Monitoring

Mercy Health staff previously spent a significant amount of time maintaining paper temperature logs. With Smart-Sense, Mercy Health manages temperature monitoring and receives alerts in real-time, rather than relying on spot-checking temperatures to catch excursions. In the past, Mercy Health had lost a significant amount of medication for one of two reasons: they did not realize in time that temperatures were out of range, or they could not determine the length of time the temperature had been out of range. With SmartSense, Mercy Health knows immediately when temperature excursions are detected. This enables proactive temperature management and allows Mercy Health to correct the temperature issue as it occurs. By implementing continuous temperature monitoring, Mercy Health has been confident that they are administering safe medicine and have not been forced to discard any valuable medications.

Automated Compliance Logging

The Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO) had cited Mercy Health for not having an automated temperature monitoring system installed for compliance and safety. Previously, healthcare professionals would periodically record temperatures that held valuable medications and manually record these temperatures on paper. This manual method was not completed to the satisfaction of the surveyors, which posed unnecessary challenges during audits. With Smart-Sense, Mercy Health has implemented an automated solution that allows them to digitally record temperatures for more robust compliance logging. A digital solution provides more accurate methods of monitoring temperatures, and offers centralized documentation that eliminates the challenges that come with pen and paper.
