Roadmap to Hybrid Innovation

The Challenge

Innovation is key to MM Group (MM), particularly in terms of creating new and improved products. But the organization wanted to **start getting feedback from employees**, including their colleagues on the shop floor, who work with their products on a daily basis.

Although they had an in-house system in place, they needed a simpler tool that would integrate into their new way of working and came with **implementation support**.

 The current in-house software was no longer up-to-date and not integrated into their systems.

They needed to keep their IT team's time free to continue to support other areas of the business.

The Solution

- The MM team originally hoped to rollout the software to plants following a European pilot, but will now be launching business-wide.
