

Care Plan Audit

MDS Staff will review and revise at least 6 resident care plans per week until 100% of residents care plans have been reviewed and revised.

- All triggered areas from the most recent CAAs are addressed in the person-centered plan of care.
- The focus statement identifies a condition, risk, or need specific to the resident.
- Goals are measurable, attainable, and relate to how the focus statement affects the resident's day to day needs and quality of life.
- Goals are given an appropriate time frame.
- Interventions are person-centered and customized to reflect the care that is needed or desired by the resident.
- Kardex is free from unnecessary information for direct care. Interventions are brief, concise, and easy to find and read by direct care staff.
- An interdisciplinary review of the plan of care has been scheduled with the next OBRA MDS Assessment.
