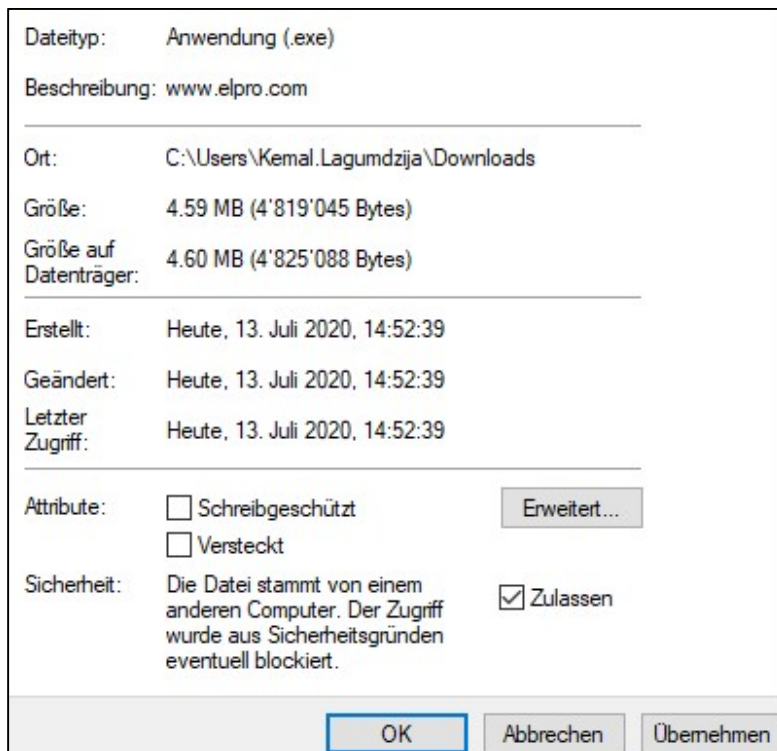


«.dll» Files

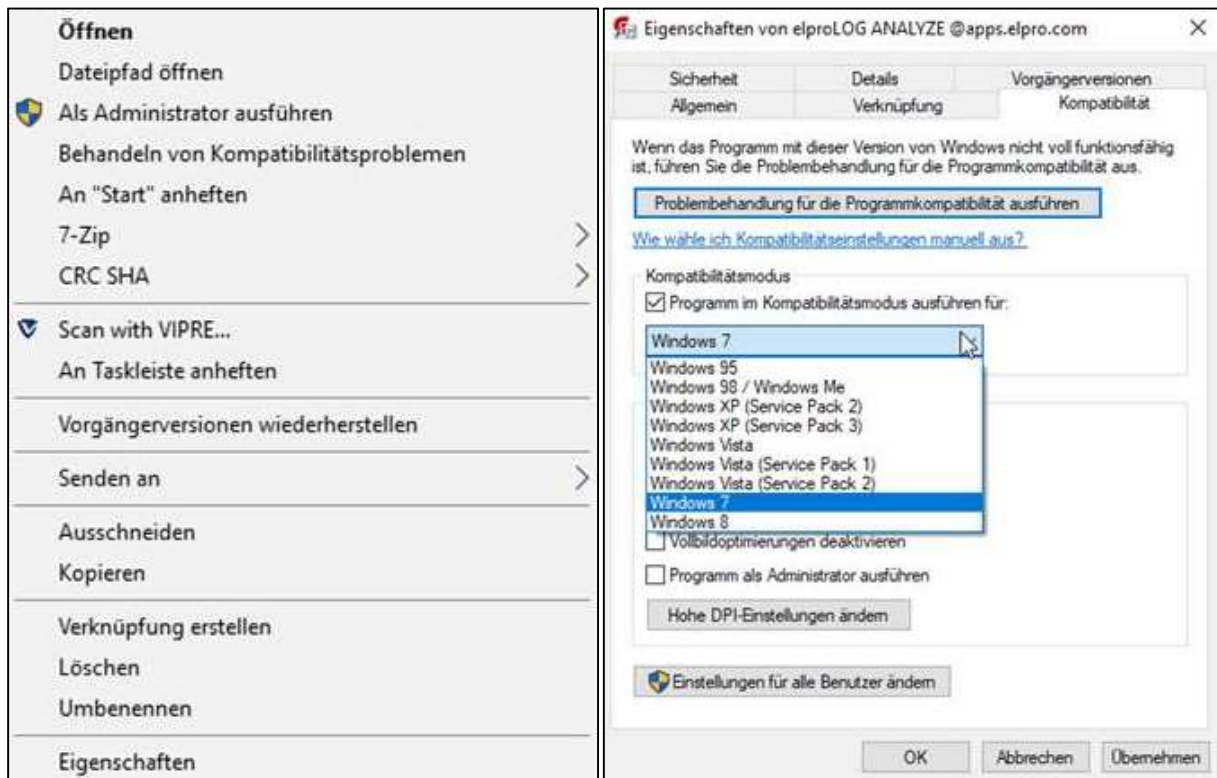
It seems that Windows 10 often blocks so-called ".dll" files after downloading them from the Internet after updating to the 2004 version, which makes them unusable for further applications. However, with the steps below we should be able to disable the system error message.

If you right-click on the .exe file after the download and go to Properties, you will see a box under Security in the lower right corner, which is called Allow, this box should be checked. Afterwards you can double click on the file to start the installation again. If the security box is empty, then the file is already considered as released by Win10.



If this does not work, there would still be the possibility to change the compatibility mode. For this you would have to right click on the elproLOG ANALYZE application on the desktop > Properties > Compatibility > Compatibility Mode > Check & choose Windows 7
