About the Workshop

In this workshop, Learners will be trained to edit images in order to enhance visuals. Using Adobe Photoshop, Learners will be equipped with the skills and techniques of Adobe Photoshop in order to edit and reconfigure images. - **How to edit and reconfigure images for the purposes of editing photographs, posters, social media posts and more**
