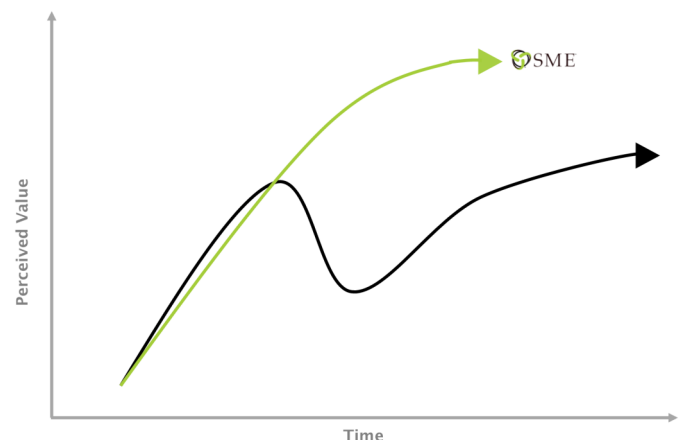

Using SCRUM and LEAN methodologies in your business requirements will encourage an agile development phase. With this combo, there is no fizzling out during the development stage.

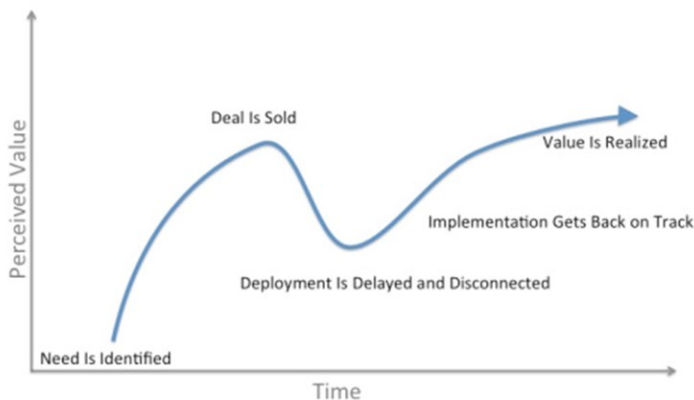
