

Supply Alert update August 31st, 2021

To AED360 partners,

MDR release approved for Europe.

Philips has shared some very positive news with us today.

All pending MDR issues have been solved. After resuming shipment of batteries and FRx devices now the HS1 and its pads will become ready for shipment.
