


Core: E911

Core allows quick view of all the numbers an account has registered for E911 use. You can add new numbers to assign it to an address, or just view the currently assigned addresses from this page.

YOU SHOULD ALWAYS TEST E911 BY CALLING 933 ON YOUR VOIP IP PHONE OR PBX



Multiple numbers may be assigned to one address, and one account may have any number of registered E911 numbers.

It is however a requirement that at least one number have an E911 address before a device may be registered.





** Beginning 2/14/2020 ALL 911 registrations will have a verified 911 notification email address.

Due to the new Kari's Law, when calls are placed to 911 a notification is to be sent to notify users that 911 has been dialed. This will need to be a validated email. Once set on the 911 registration an email will be sent to the email address listed within the registration. This email must be verified before the registration can be used on any device.
