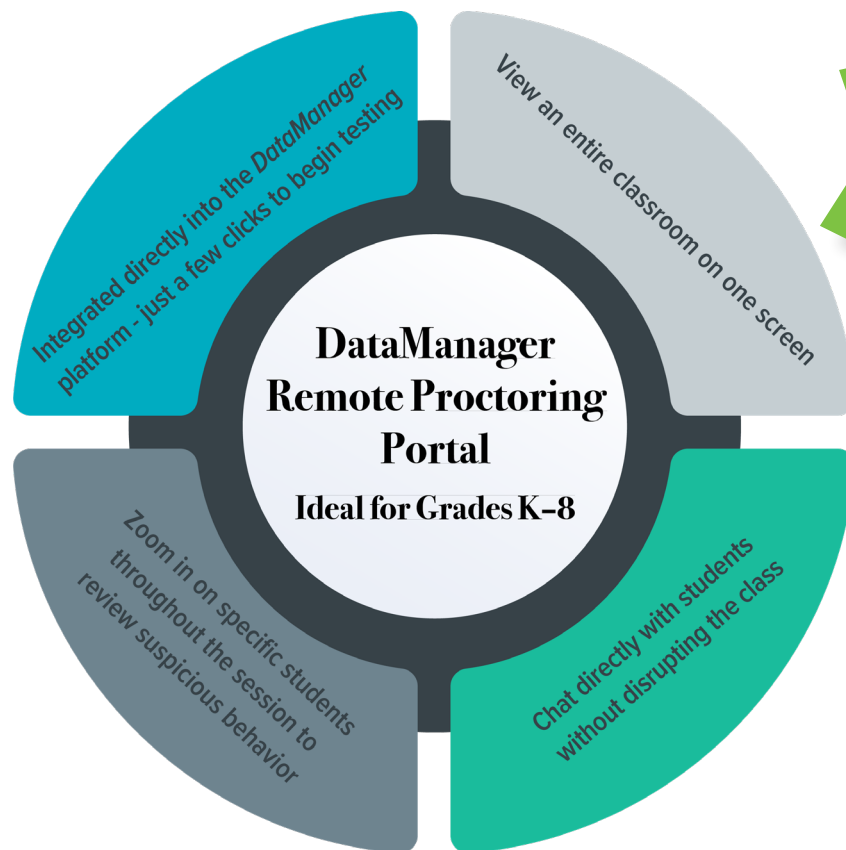

Key Features

- Students interact with a familiar adult – teacher or local proctor
- Proctor can communicate in-app via 1:1 or 1:M chat
- Integration of application directly into *DataManager* proctoring tool set (a few clicks in the app)
- Proctor has better visibility of student testing environments (Zoom in on a single student and easily zoom out to see many students in one frame)
- With dual monitors, proctors can keep an eye on a single or few students on a large screen while still monitoring the class
- Students can chat with the proctor without chatting to the entire group
- Proctors can easily pause a single student session or an entire group test session

Simple Steps for the Students and the Proctor

Device requirements

- If the student's testing device has a webcam, that's all they need
- If the student's device does NOT have a webcam, students can download an app on a video-enabled device (iPads, Androids, etc.) to serve as their webcam

Once the devices are set up, the proctor

- Signs in to *DataManager*
- Launches the proctor session
- Instructs students to sign in to start system check tools
- Approves the students for testing (1 by 1 to ensure each child is ready to test)
- Sees the status of each student in the phases of approval
- Can select 'Approve All' to begin the test once all students are ready
- Monitors the views of group and individual students
- Can toggle between traditional proctor dashboard and monitoring tool (tile view and zoom-in view of a student + chat stream)



Detecting cheating

- Parents sign a test security letter (updated version will be provided in the Remote Testing Playbook)
- Students consent to the 'Terms & Conditions' during the testing setup and approval process
- This solution empowers proctors and teachers to identify suspicious behavior by monitoring students via webcam as well as viewing recordings after the test session if needed
- What does it record? Just the webcam view of the student behavior
- What about the secure browser? The solution can be used with or without Riverside's secure browser
- To use the secure browser, ensure parents and students have this downloaded to the device ahead of the test session (new version of the secure browser will be required; will be provided)



Pausing test sessions

- Proctors can pause test sessions for an individual student or group of students (i.e., student needs to go to the restroom, internet glitch, etc.)



Chat

- The chat is only visible between the individual student and the proctor



Distractions

- Student cannot see the other students or the proctor



Check readiness

- System check tools can be run prior to the time of testing
