Tools

Strike a balance between open source and proprietary tools.

Know when to take the time and effort required to build value from scratch, and when to leverage existing resources.



Vendor-Neutral

Build a cloud-neutral technology stack that will outlast all the vendors.

Avoiding vendor lock-in today will give you freedom and optionality tomorrow.



Multi-Cloud

Embrace a multi-cloud strategy, but don't just the same workload on multiple clouds.

Run different apps and workloads on different clouds, depending on which cloud is fit for which purpose.



Cloud Native

Find cloud native equivalents for legacy tools and operational processes.

The cloud will exaggerate any weaknesses in outdated systems and require more resources from them.



Plan

Define your goals of what you wish to take from the cloud, so you can identify what value you must create for yourself with open source tools.



Outsource

Outsource operations your technical teams don't excel in, whose differentiation doesn't matter to the business.
