



## Before Surgery Indications

### Recommended care before your surgery

- **DO NOT** take Aspirin at least 5 days before your surgery
- **DO NOT** Smoke a month before your surgery
- Suspend any supplements 1 week before your surgery
- If you suffer from constipation take a mild laxative 2 days before surgery
- **Do NOT take laxatives 1 day before or on the day of your surgery**
- It is recommended that you take Arnica tea 5 days before your surgery and / or take Arnica SinEcch capsules 1 day before surgery (available at our clinic, more information below)

*If you are taking any prescribed medication please advise the doctor beforehand, to see if you may take your medications regularly.*

### Items to purchase before surgery

- **Arnica Tea and / or Arnica Capsules:** It is recommended that you take Arnica tea 5 days before your surgery and / or take Arnica SinEcch capsules 1 day before surgery and after. You can buy it in our office the day before or of your surgery. Arnica is an herbal supplement that serves as an aid in the treatment of inflammation or bruising. (Arnica capsules (14 in a box) for \$40)
- **SPF-30 or greater-** The incision of your nose is sensitive to sunlight after surgery. Protect the incision line from sun exposure.
- **Stool softener** -It is fairly common to get constipated with medications after surgery, we recommend you use a mild laxative. You can purchase;Ducolax, Miralax, Metamucil, or Peri-Colace or a mild laxative of your preference. You can take a mild laxant **2 DAYS BEFORE YOUR SURGERY.** After then, it should be stopped. These should be started the day after surgery. **DO NOT TAKE LAXANTS THE DAY BEFORE OR THE DAY OF SURGERY!**
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- **Oral Thermometer** -It is important to monitor your temperature after surgery in the event that you feel "feverish" or hot. You have a fever if you have a temperature above 101.5.
- **Q-tips**
- **Hydrogen peroxide.**
- **Additional drip pads or gauzes (optional)-** We will provide a small pack of gauzes before you leave, please have additional gauzes in case you have a bloody nasal discharge.
- **Micropore Tape (optional)-** During your revisions, we will be changing your nose tape, you have may purchase an additional micropore tape to wear 2 weeks after surgery .



## 1 Day before Surgery

The day before your surgery, you must hydrate and have a light meal. Before going to bed drink a good amount of water!

**If your surgery is scheduled in the morning** (any time between 7:00 am-11:00 am) suspend any liquid or food intake at 12:00 am.

**If your surgery is scheduled in the afternoon or late afternoon** (any time between 12:00pm - 8:00 pm) suspend any liquid or food intake **8 hours before** your surgery. Make sure your last meal is healthy and not too heavy.

If you are taking any additional medications, please advise the doctor

After your surgery you will not be able to drive back home. For this matter, it is recommended to have only **1 companion** with you.

## Indications

1. Report of any drug allergies
2. Avoid drinks or food, at least 8 hours before the operation
3. Unpainted nails, avoid makeup and moisturizing cream. Do not bring jewelry or piercings. You can use deodorant and take your regular shower.
4. You can brush your teeth without drinking any liquids
5. In case of having been marked the day before the operation, DO NOT ERASE MARKS during your bath.
6. Notify if you take any type of medication and if so, bring medications to continue treatment during your stay.
7. After the surgery you **will not be able** to drive vehicles, so it is recommended to **come accompanied**. Please **DO NOT bring more than 1 companion due to this pandemic**. We recommend you are accompanied at all times during your recovery time, at least for the first 3-5 days. Post-Op indications will be provided after surgery.
8. If you use removable pieces in your mouth and / or contact lenses, please notify us and bring a case
9. If you are on your period on the day of surgery, please notify your nurse or doctor.

### Day of Surgery:

- You must arrive to the clinic a day before or in the morning of your surgery date (day indicated by the doctor) for your pre operative exams, photos, and for your marking.
- The rest of the surgery will be charged the day of your surgery before your operation

### Optional Items to bring with you

- Comfortable pajamas and underclothes
- Travel items for your stay (if required)
- You may bring any smart devices such as an iPad or to connect with HDMI for your entertainment
- Contact lens Case
- Pesos currency in case you or your guest needs to purchase anything during your stay
- Passport, Visa, or any travel documents to cross the US boarder

Post Op Care instructions will be provided after surgery.

### Night Stay

**Ambulatory procedures:** Almost every procedure is ambulatory (dispatched same day of surgery), it is not required for patients to stay one night in out clinic unless indicated by the doctor.

Only for tummy tucks, facelifts, and butt augmentation with implants patients will be discharged 24 hours after surgery or until the doctor indicates.

- During your night stay patients will be provided a light breakfast meal.

## Exams

You will arrive the day before or on the agreed day with Dr. López for your preoperative exams and to clarify any doubts.

## Required Exams

<b>For all patients:</b> <b>Preoperative blood tests:</b> TP TTP CBC Platelets HIV	
<b>For patients over 30 years old</b> -an electrocardiogram	<b>For over 40 years</b> -preoperative evaluation with the cardiologist

- Covid-19 PCR Exam (We do not have this exam available at our clinic, it should be taken in your hometown). **NO MORE than 5 days BEFORE** your surgery

## Payments

The rest of the surgery will be charged the day of your surgery before your operation. We require a minimum of 30% of your surgery to be paid in cash. The rest can be paid by debit or credit card (American express, visa, MasterCard) ( if payed with American Express, you can pay up to \$3000 and no more than 50% of the total cost of your surgery). contact us if you have questions on payment methods.

**Additional costs:** Additional payments to consider include pre operatory exams, medications, and additional but optional items.

Bloodwork- \$110 (additional \$10 for rush fee if done the day of surgery, \$120)
Electrogram (patients over 30)- \$55
Covid-19 test- \$100
Rhinoplasty Medications: Approximately \$180
