




CASE STUDY



Three decades of ice cream delight at Brean Leisure Park

As early as 1947 Unity Farm, previously a dairy farm, located in the coastal village of Brean, near Burnham-on-Sea, has been home to some form of campsite. The cows have long since gone from Holiday Resort Unity, the new name for the farm, while the last seven decades has seen the site transformed into one of the South West's leading holiday and leisure destinations, including a theme park, waterpark, 18-hole golf course, 200-acre holiday park and wide selection of catering outlets.

The Tavern is our main catering outlet, providing a traditional family friendly restaurant menu and popular Sunday carvery, while seven takeaways including fish and chips, a Wimpy and Subway franchise, a Chinese and an Indian provide real variation. In addition to these we also have a selection of cafés and of course our very own ice cream parlour – well no seaside resort would be complete without one!"
