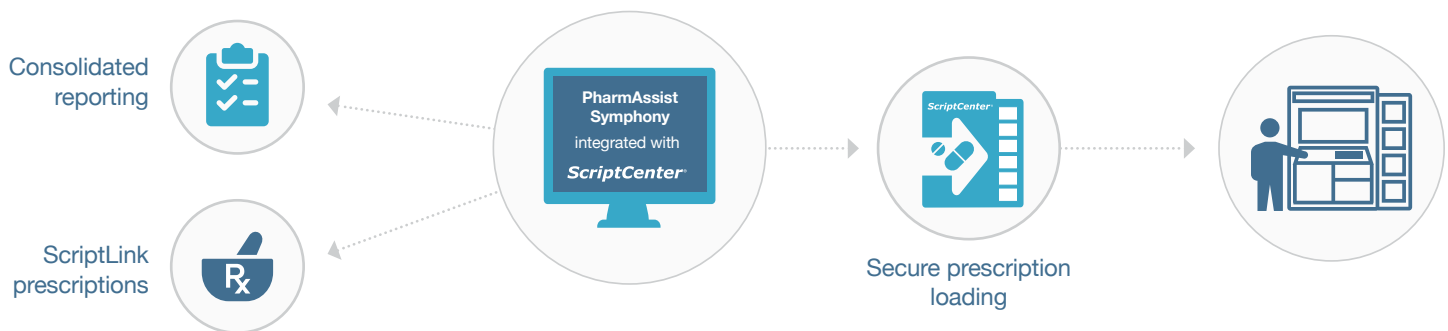

ScriptCenter meets high-level security requirements



Asteres holds a DHA RMF ATO accreditation at the MAC III Sensitive level for the ScriptCenter system. This accreditation allows ScriptCenter to be connected to the facility or MedCOI network.



ScriptCenter systems receive prescription data from MHS Genesis, CHCS, or Innovation's PharmAssist Symphony to enable prescription preparation and pickup.

Integrated Pharmacy Workflow

ScriptCenter bi-directional MHS Genesis connection exists through the interface with PharmAssist Symphony

- MHS Genesis Data can be retrieved by ScriptCenter from PharmAssist Symphony
- Ability to automatically change a status in PharmAssist Symphony of a prescription to "picked up" when a prescription is retrieved out of ScriptCenter
- Signature capture is sent to PharmAssist Symphony, providing a complete fulfillment record in a single system
- Overall reduction of manual input or manual data
