

2021 Full Predator Season Tickets

Following the success of the Predator Season Ticket scheme, we are pleased to announce the following details for 2021/22. Full predator season tickets will be priced at £630.00pp. Please see below for further information:

Entitlement	8 single rod days fly fishing from a boat within the fishing season purchased. Single rod days are only bookable in advance by the discretion of Bristol Water Fisheries.
	2 boat day in dead bait/lure pike fishing sessions in following fishing season
	Preferential advanced booking of dead bait/lure fishing entitlement for the following season
	Preferential booking window is in advance of dead bait/lure fishing tickets going on general sale
	Preferential booking window will be via phone and the order in which predator season ticket holders will be called will be randomised. We will use a computer generated randomiser for this procedure. Should there be no response from the ticket holder we will place their name at the bottom of the list. Once a name is drawn, the customer will be able to book all dead bait days associated with their predator season tickets.
Eligibility	Unrestricted. Anyone may purchase up to a maximum of 2 predator season tickets per person per year of any variation.
Availability	Overall availability is limited to 200 tickets per year
	Current holders of a predator season ticket will be offered the opportunity to renew their tickets in advance of general sale.
	Individual availability is limited to two Predator season tickets per person per year
	Predator season tickets go on general sale from 28th January 2021

Refunds	Refundable only by cancellation of fishing by Bristol Water Fisheries
	Cancellation refunds to be provided on a pro-rata basis i.e. proportion of ticket price as applicable

Ghillie / guide services	Ticket holders shall not provide ghillie/guide services on these tickets.
	Non-compliance to this condition will result in forfeit of predator season ticket without refund, and offender may be subject to potential exclusion from the fishery in accordance with the fishery enforcement policy.
