

## Wells Road, Worth



We're replacing the water mains across Wells Road, Worth and some of the surrounding residential roads. The works will improve odour, pressure and taste as well as ensuring your water supply is reliable.

We started the work in summer 2019. We've had to work in small sections at a time because the roads in this area are extremely narrow.

#### Why is the diversion so long?

Other roads in the area are too narrow and unable to cope with high volumes of traffic, this is the only suitable route as agreed with Somerset County Council.



#### Why do you need to close the road?

The road is too narrow so we cannot work under traffic lights. This also protects the nearby stream from contamination. We'll be working as quickly as we can.

#### Will you cover my fuel costs?

We are unable to cover the cost of your travel. We apologise for any inconvenience.


#### What about service providers?

Local providers are aware of the works but if you have any concerns, it's best to get in touch with your e.g., bus provider directly. Emergency services will always be given access. We've contacted residents within the closure area separately.

# I just saw someone go through the closure. Why won't you let me go through the closure?

Residents who live in the boundaries of the road closure are permitted to access their properties. Residents will have received a permit from us.

We're really sorry but it is not possible to let anyone else through the road closure. The reason for this is that we need to pause our works and start covering the exposed road. This is time consuming and means we may then have to push back our finished date for the works meaning our disruption goes on for far longer.

#### Interruptions to supply



If you live in the area, we may need to turn your water supply off to connect your home to our new water main. If this is needed, we'll always warn you 48 hours in advance by posting the dates and times through your letterbox.
