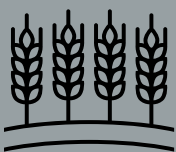

We focus on four pillars of transitional help; education, adaptive sports, rehabilitation, and employment. Through our mission, we strive to help those communities in need through volunteer and financial efforts while also inspiring others in the financial field to do the same.



Dog Tag Inc. is a non-profit based in Washington, DC whose mission is to build a bridge to business employment and a productive civilian life for veterans and military families. Dog Tag's "Learning Labs" provides real-life work experience for service-disabled veterans, military spouses, and caregivers in the organization's small business venture, Dog Tag Bakery.



Our partnership with the Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation allows us to honor this country's men and women in uniform by enabling their children to attend college. The MCSF is the nation's oldest and largest provider of need-based scholarships to military children, providing access to affordable education for the children of Marine and Navy Corpsman attending post-high school, under-graduate, and career technical education programs for more than 55 years.



Merging Vets with Players was designed to address the struggle faced by veterans transitioning their abilities towards a new mission: leading themselves, their families, and their communities when they return home. By merging vets and players, an environment is created where warriors can share each other's strengths and can support each other in building fulfilling lives of service and strength.



Stay in Step Brain and Spinal Cord Injury Recovery Center is a non-profit recovery center designed to provide state-of-the-art recovery treatment to SCI patients in the Tampa and surrounding community area.
