It is the utilization of strategic planning, developing a well-being baseline, and applying Priority Based Budgeting that helps achieve the overarching goal of great governance.

STRATEGIC PLANNING FRAMEWORK Alignment of focus between Community – Council – Municipal Operations. Clarity of Purpose that thrives for a generation or more. With both alignment and clarity come expectations of commitment and performance to achieve well-being success for all stakeholders.

The framework includes a set of robust goals, strategies to achieve the goals and measures that identify when success has been achieved.

WELL-BEING Baseline A powerful tool in creating a richer relationship between the community and the municipality is understanding the well-being of citizens — today, tomorrow and into the future. The relationship becomes one of driving value for community investments as opposed to minimizing tax increases. Value is determined by returns achieved in furthering well-being for all.

PRIORITY BASED BUDGFTING Priority Based budgeting is a common sense, data-driven approach to budgeting and decision making. The philosophy of PBB is that resources should be allocated according to how effectively a program or service achieves the strategic plan, and goals, that are of most significant value to the community. Providing reallocation opportunities to address key objectives such as climate change, equity, well-being, homelessness and sustainability.
