LU	WER SCHOOL Grades 1-5
	Application: Submit the Application and the Application fee of \$50.00 per student to FCS.
	Records Release Form: Complete and submit Form to the student's current school.
	Teacher Recommendation Form(s): Distribute to student's current teacher(s).
	Rising First Grade: K-1 Teacher Recommendation Form – 1 recommendation required.
	Rising Grades (2-5): 2-5 Teacher Recommendation Form – 2 recommendations required.
	Standardized Test Scores: Submit copy of student's most recent math and reading comprehension scores (Grades 3-5). Acceptable tests include Iowa Test of Basic Skills, Stanford Achievement Test, or similar test. State SOL and PAL tests are not accepted. If scores are not available from student's school, local Learning Centers administer these tests.
	Visit: Schedule a visit to Faith Christian School, at least a half day, and preferably a full day (Grades 2-5).
	Assessment: We will schedule your child's assessment with a Lower School Teacher when we receive Application.
	Parent Interview: Scheduled with Director of Enrollment upon completion of above.
MI	IDDLE AND UPPER SCHOOL Grades 6-12
	Application: Submit the Application and the Application fee of \$50.00 per student to FCS.
	Records Release Form: Complete and submit Form to the student's current school.
	Teacher Recommendation Form(s): Distribute the Math and English Teacher Recommendation Forms to the student's current Math and English teachers.
	Standardized Test Scores: Submit copy of student's most recent math and reading comprehension scores. Acceptable tests include Iowa Test of Basic Skills, Stanford Achievement Test, or similar test. State SOL and PAL tests are not accepted. If scores are not available from student's school, local Learning Centers administer these tests.
	Visit: Schedule a visit to Faith Christian School, at least a half day, and preferably a full day.
	Assessment: We will schedule your child's assessment when we receive Application.
	Family Interview: Scheduled with parents, student, and Director of Enrollment upon completion of above.
