

Nikko AM KiwiSaver Scheme - Permanent Emigration Withdrawal Form

PLEASE NOTE: This form excludes emigration to Australia – you will need to complete an Australian Superannuation Transfer Form if you wish to transfer your Nikko AM KiwiSaver account balance to Australia, otherwise your funds must remain in a KiwiSaver scheme until you are entitled to withdraw them for another reason.

CHECKLIST

Your application needs to include the following:

- your completed, signed Permanent Emigration Withdrawal Form
 proof of the bank account for payment of the withdrawal (section 2)
 certified copies of proof of your identity and residential address (section 3)
 your original statutory declaration signed by you, and taken by a person authorised to take statutory declarations in your country of residence (section 5)
 evidence you've permanently left New Zealand, for example:
 - confirmed travel and/or shipping arrangements
 - passport evidence (photo, signature and relevant stamped pages proving departure)
 - evidence of any visas
 - shipping contracts or supporting movement documentation
 - evidence of overseas employment (for example, a copy of a contract or letter from your overseas employer confirming your length of service and/or employment start date)
- □ evidence that you live permanently overseas, for example:
 - a copy of a sale and purchase agreement for an overseas property
 - tenancy/leasing agreement for an overseas property
 - evidence of your overseas tax status issued by the relevant overseas tax authority

If you provide us with all the requested details with your application, the process including consideration of your application, may take up to 5 business days. If we need to ask you for any additional information, this will cause delays in approval, so it's important you read this application form, including the checklist, and complete it correctly and fully.

3. Identification and Proof of Address

As part of your application, you must provide copies of your ID and proof of address. Please provide us with either:

- a copy of your current passport (page showing your name, date of birth, photograph and signature), or-a copy
 of your current driver licence showing your name, signature and expiry date, AND a bank account statement
 or document that contains your full name and addressed to you by a New Zealand registered bank within the
 last 3 months, or statement from any New Zealand government department addressed to you dated within
 the last 3 months, or New Zealand SuperGold card, or birth certificate,
- a copy of your current firearms licence.

AND one of the following issued and dated within the last 3 months, showing your name and current residential address:

- Bank statement
- Utility bill (e.g. power or home phone bill)
- Rates bill
- Letter or statement from a NZ government agency

Who can certify your documents?

If you are overseas, your documents must be certified by a person authorised by law in that country to take statutory declarations or equivalent in the country you are applying from. Your certifier must state what authorises them to be able to certify these documents e.g. NR stamp, CA stamp etc.

The following people can certify photocopies of original documents as true and correct copies:

- Notary Public
- Justice of the Peace
- Member of the Police
- New Zealand lawyer
- New Zealand Chartered Accountant
- A person who has legal authority to take statutory declarations (or equivalent) in New Zealand.



Please note that the certifier must be at least 16 years of age and cannot be:

- a person involved in the transaction requiring the certification
- related to you
- your spouse or partner
- a person who lives at the same address as you.

Copies of ID and proof of address must be recently certified (in the previous three months) as a true copy of the original which represents your identity by one of the people listed above.

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5. Statutory Declaration

A statutory declaration is a written statement that allows a person to declare something to be true. You'll need to complete this page including signing it, in front of an authorised person. You'll make the declaration, and the person witnessing will take the declaration.

Who can witness the declaration?

The following persons can witness you making the declaration:

- Notary Public
- Justice of the Peace
- Person enrolled as a barrister and solicitor of the High Court
