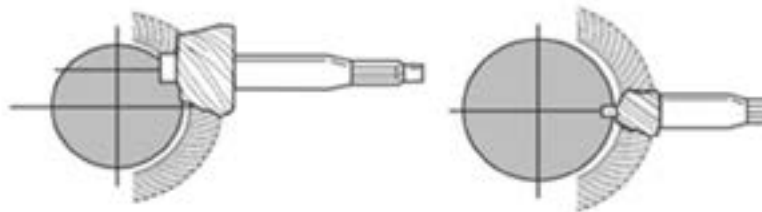


## Updated Pinion Yokes



The yoke on the left is the old style without any types of sleeve. The new style yoke on the right is produced by AAM and comes with a stainless steel sleeve protecting it from premature wear. This design is used on most GM 7.5", 8.5", 8.6", 9.5" etc. You can use this new style in place of the old style but must sell the updated pinion seal do to the inside diameter changing.

## High Pinion and Center Line



The pinion on the right (Spiral Bevel) shows it setup with the center line which means it is a standard rotation. The pinion on the left (Hypoid Gearset) shows the pinion above the center line. Experience technicians may order parts and tell you that he has a "high pinion" that indicates he has a reverse rotation.
